**Q: WHO?**

**A: Your Classroom and MMA Docents**

In order to accommodate positive experiences in our galleries, we require there be one classroom in the building at a time with chaperones (1 per 10 students) to accompany them. Due to our current size and the current average classroom size, this proves to be the safest for the artwork and provide the best experience for the students!

If you are traveling downtown Muskegon with other classrooms, and want all of the students to visit the MMA we encourage you to divide your experiences between our museum and library neighbors\*! For example: while classroom A is with us here at the MMA, classroom B can be next door at the library. And then the classrooms can switch locations so everyone is experiencing the same content!
