To facilitate positive experiences in our galleries, we only allow one classroom in the building at a time with chaperones [1 per 10 students] accompanying. Due to our current size and the average classroom, this is safest for the artwork and provides the best experience for students.

Traveling in downtown Muskegon with other classrooms?  
Want all of your students to visit the MMA? We encourage you to divide your experiences between our museum and library neighbors\*!

Example: Classroom A at MMA, Classroom B at Hackley Library. Classes can switch locations halfway the total visit time so everyone can experience the same content!
